CHANGE THE DEFAULT OPENING FOLDER IN WINDOWS EXPLORER

By default, Windows Explorer opens showing the My Documents folder. To change the default setting so that all top-level drives and folders are shown, follow these steps:

Click **Start**, point to Programs, then Accessories, then right-click **Windows Explorer**, and click **Properties**.

Under Target field, which reads `%SystemRoot%\explorer.exe`, add to make the line read `%SystemRoot%\explorer.exe /n, /e, /select, C:\`

Click **OK**.

Now when you open Windows Explorer you get to choose from all the folders and drives, not just My Documents.
